

FEDERAL FY 2006

Interest –

- HAVA Title II Requirements Payment:

All interest earned from July 2003 through June 2005 on Title I and Title II money was deposited in our HAVA Title I fund (our master HAVA fund). Interest for that time period was reported on our Title I reports. Beginning in June 2005, we began having interest reported per each federal appropriation; thus, Title I and Title II interest are now tracked separately and HAVA Title II was first reflected in our FFY05 report.

Total interest earned on requirements payments - \$1,092,377.67

- 5% State Match: FFY 05 interest earned \$17,873.55

Kansas' state match is broken down into 3% State, 2% County. In Federal FY 06 we earned \$17,873.55 interest on our 2% County portion. There was no interest earned on the 3% State portion. The State does not allow interest on general fund appropriations without specific statutory authority. We do not have that authority but will be working with the appropriate state entities to try to resolve the issue.
